

#### Rights and Responsibilities of Students

- www.ft.um.si → Course Catalogs
- Syllabi, literature (listed in the course catalog), guidelines for written assignments.
- Method of assessment (written, oral, seminar papers, project work, etc.) following the grading scale.
- Required attendance.
- Execution of fieldwork and excursions (when, where, cost).
- Time and location of office hours.



#### Unacceptable

- Cheating
- Plagiarism

The following measures may be taken for breach of duty and non-fulfilment of students' obligations:

- reminder,
- ban on taking the exam,
- exclusion from the university for a period of up to two years,
- permanent exclusion from the university.



#### Plagiarism

- Plagiarism is any presentation of someone else's work as one's own.
- The extent of plagiarism is irrelevant in defining it. Plagiarism can consist of a single sentence (a key sentence in the paper, an idea) or an entire work.
- All seminar papers, research papers, essays, and all final works prepared by students during their studies must be the student's own work.
- In their work, students should always clearly distinguish between their own ideas and knowledge and the information obtained from other sources.





# SLOVENE LANGUAGE & CULTURE COURSE

- Začetna integracija priseljencev Early Integration of Immigrants
  - To provide foreigners who are not citizens of the European Union with knowledge of the Slovenian language necessary to successfully pass the basic-level Slovenian language proficiency exam (A2/B1 according to the CEFR), or with language skills at a level required for basic communication. The process of learning Slovenian also includes topics from everyday life and work, which support the integration of immigrants into Slovenian society.



# SLOVENE LANGUAGE & CULTURE COURSE

- Course outline & duration: Learning the Slovenian language and becoming acquainted with Slovenian history, culture, and constitutional system. // 180 hrs.
- Organized by: Cene Štupar
- Location: Ljubljana (BTC and Ježica)
- Fee: No cost!
- What you need: UE certificate (& FT statement, proof of enrollment ...)
- What you get: A1 certificate (no charge)

# REGISTRATION FOR ENROLMENT AND TESTING YOUR PRIOR-KNOWLEDGE

You can apply for the free Slovenian language course if you already have a certificate issued by the Administrative Unit (only Claim is not valid). You can apply online via the online application form. You will also need to attach a picture of the certificate so that we can check the suitability. Choose the time of the course and click on the relevant link below.

Courses in the morning take place approximately between 8:30 and 12:00. To enrol in the Slovenian course, which will take place in the morning, please apply **HERE** (click).

The mid-day courses take place approximately between 12:00 and 16:00. To enrol in the mid-day Slovenian course, please apply **HERE** (click).

The evening courses take place approximately between 17:00 and 21:15. To enrol in the evening Slovenian course, please apply **HERE** (click).

Weekend courses are intended for those who cannot attend a course during the week. To register for the course during weekends, register <a href="HERE">HERE</a> (click).

Courses are usually held 2 or 3 times a week for 4 school hours. The courses in Grosuplje, Kamnik, Domžale and Vrhnika are generally only held in the evening and are intended only for Slavic speakers (Bosnian speakers, Russian speakers, Serbian speakers, Ukrainian speakers).
